The serious corner:

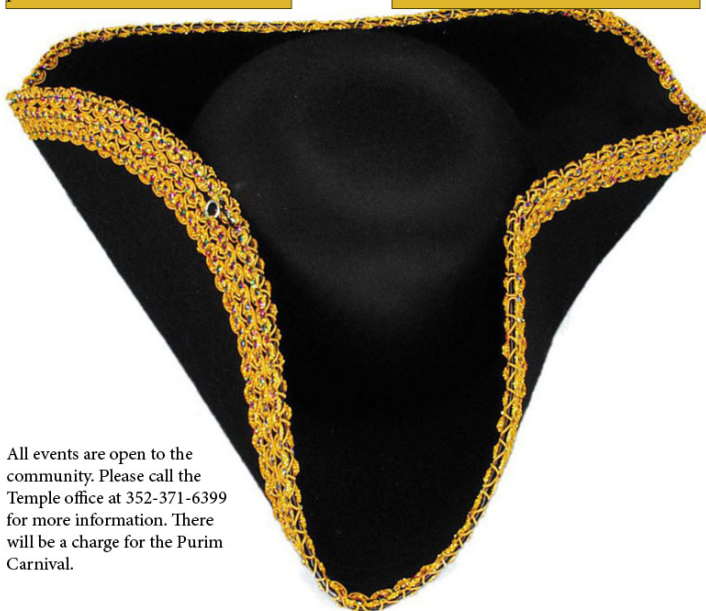
Friday, March 6, 7:00 pm

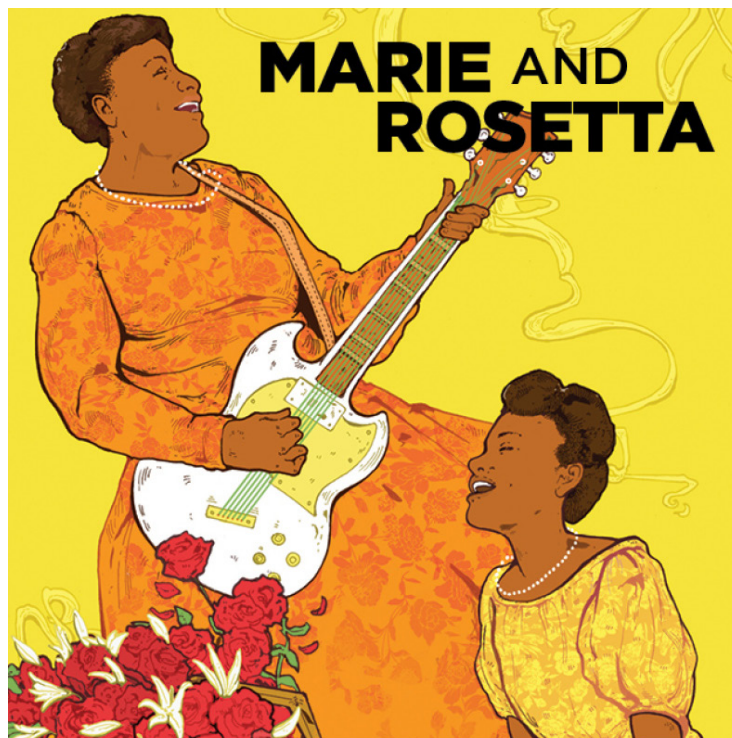

Enjoy an outing to the Hippodrome on Sunday, March 15 for a matinee performance of "Marie and Rosetta," followed by an optional dinner downtown.

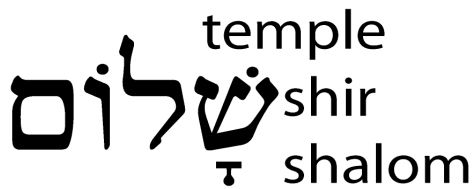

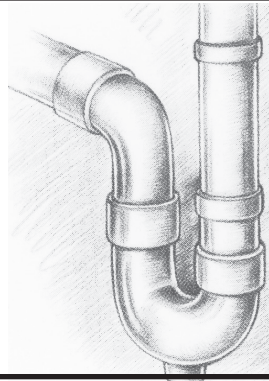

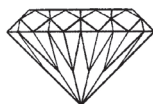
